

HBHTA Bylaw Committee Report
Annual Meeting
June 11, 2022

- A review of the Bylaws took place first by a committee and then by the entire Trustee board.
- The priority was to clean up the document and make it concise, clear, and have it be accurately reflective of operations.

- A few examples:
 - ⇒ Officer responsibilities were spelled out and it was clarified that Officers are Trustees
 - ⇒ Terms of trustees and officers will be tracked.
 - ⇒ Nominating committee work was spelled out
 - ⇒ Fiscal year and budget deadlines were aligned with the operating year
 - ⇒ In Article 3 and 6 wording was changed that referenced membership in the HBHTA from property owner to real estate taxpayer to be more inclusive.
