ORDINANCES PROPOSED (first reading)

22-16: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$987,000 to replace four water mains in the Township (covers equipment and the labor) at 77th Street, Mea Lane, Seagull Avenue and West Harrington Avenue (all in or around Brant Beach)

22-17: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$189,500 to repair and resurface Hobart Avenue in Holgate

22-18: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$3,500,000 for the modernization of the water treatment plant in Holgate

22-19: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$2,850,000 to construct storm water pump stations at 13th Street in North Beach Haven (despite its name, this area is part of LBT), 27th Street in Spray Beach and 35th Street in Brant Beach

LBI SHUTTLE BUS - There's an app for that, as you are probably aware, and at some point next week, enhancements to that app will be available that allow you to know even more specifically where a particular bus is on the island.

The shuttles run every day until Labor Day from 10 am – 10 pm. Cost is free for ages 12 & under when accompanied by an adult; \$2 one-way fare until 7 pm; \$5 one-way fare after 7 pm. A season pass may be purchased for \$125 at the 68th St Brant Beach Badge Shack.

NINJA WARRIOR AT THE SHORE A company called Nex Level Ninja has partnered with LBT to bring what they describe as “the Ninja Warrior experience” to Bay View Park at 68th Street in Brant Beach for a month. Next Level Ninja has set up a mobile course with over 200 feet of Ninja obstacles to try.

OPEN PLAY is designed for kids (age 5 or older) and adults. Open play is unstructured, but Ninja Helpers are there to guide you through the obstacles and give you tips and tricks to traverse your way through the course.

About two dozen people attended the public meeting and a few posed questions to the mayor and commissioners about a variety of topics: construction of the terminal groin in Holgate; crab trap regulations; weekend recreational activities around the Municipal Building at 68th Street; wind socks; Brant Beach street repaving schedule; recycling plastic bags and the lighting at the Beach Haven Terrace pavilion (again, in spite of its name, part of LBT).
