Additional Trash Receptacles In response to a request from LPOA, the commissioners said that more trash receptacles could be placed at Tract 91. We will follow up.

Ordinances Proposed (first reading) Second readings with final voting are scheduled for the next LBT public meeting Wednesday September 7 at 4 pm.

22-20C: Establishes set-backs for air conditioning units and other such equipment

22-21C: Prohibits carrying guns into government buildings (including the LBT municipal building), in parks and on beaches in LBT

Ordinances Passed on Second Reading

22-16: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$987,000 to replace four water mains all in or around Brant Beach (equipment & labor)

22-17: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$189,500 to repair and resurface Hobart Avenue in Holgate

22-18: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$3,500,000 for the modernization of the water treatment plant in Holgate

22-19: Authorizes the issuance of a general bond for \$2,850,000 to construct storm water pump stations at 13th Street in North Beach Haven, 27th Street in Spray Beach and 35th Street in Brant Beach

Parental Presence Required Commissioner Lattanzi reminded everyone that an executive order, revised last year, is still in effect: Throughout the Township, those 17 years of age and younger must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian when they are on any public street, in a public area or on unimproved private property between 10 pm - 5 am.

This mandate has been in effect for two years, issued after officials continually witnessed groups of teenagers congregating in large numbers in a manner described as unsafe and volatile.

Water & Sewer Rates for 2023 Commissioner Bayard said that it was too soon to determine the rate structure for next year because we still have one more peak usage month to go in the season. Later this the fall, usage will be analyzed and new rates will be proposed.
